Directions to OKC Class Facilities: Classes will be held at Frontier State Bank, 5100 South I-35 in Oklahoma City. The bank is located just north of the corner of I-35 and SE 51st Street. **If you are traveling south on I-35:** exit 123A toward SE 51st Street. Turn left onto 51st Street, cross the interstate and turn left onto the I-35 service road. The bank is just north of the intersection. **If you are traveling north on I-35:** Exit on SE 51st Street and follow the service road to the bank. The main entrance is on the north side of the building, but please park on the east side so bank patrons have easy access. Take the elevator to the 2nd floor. (Thanks to Frontier State Bank!)
