

OHEA Homebuyer Education Curriculum Guide

OHEA has developed the OHEA **Homebuyer Education Curriculum Guide** that presents the core information for homebuyer education and explains key concepts. We believe the curriculum exceeds any national standard because while we are careful to include all topics that national panels agree should be addressed, we can reduce confusion by presenting laws, terminology and business practices that are specific to Oklahoma. The curriculum presents all of the material that should be covered in a basic homebuyer education class, plus helpful handouts and checklists to share with participants, a glossary and other teaching aids.

The complete guide is 440 pages, tabbed in 2 ½" 3 ring binder available from OHEA for \$40 plus \$10 shipping and handling.
